
What is Youth Work

Youth work helps young people learn about themselves, others and society through activities that combine enjoyment, challenge, learning and achievement.









Youth work offers young people safe spaces to explore their identity, experience decision-making, increase their confidence, develop inter-personal skills and think through the consequences of their actions. This leads to better informed choices, changes in behaviour and improved outcomes for young people.

The Jersey Youth Service seeks to promote young people's personal and social development and enable them to have a voice, influence and place in their community, Parish and society as a whole.

Young People Are

Independent, help run the project, and educating peers. Registering as staff or exiting from project membership.

Taking a leadership role, helping to plan pieces of work, leading meetings and accepting responsibility for their actions.

Adopting a positive role, taking responsibility for planning and leading pieces of work whilst supporting peers and staff

Making own decisions, appropriately challenging, engaging in decision making and participating in groups.

Demonstrating self awareness, taking part in projects and starting to take basic responsibilities.

Taking part in activities, building relationships, and acknowledging opportunities available.

Gaining a basic knowledge of the project, what it offers and how to take part.

Acknowledging boundaries and gaining a basic knowledge of the facilities.

Meeting staff, young people and being introduced to facilities.
