

The Skills Jersey Traineeship Programme is a one-year full-time programme for 16 to 19 year olds. It is an opportunity for personal development before embarking into the world of employment through work experience, one-to-one coaching and further 'real-world' related study.



The Skills Jersey Traineeship Programme will replace the previous Trackers Foundation Programme.

It will benefit:

- Those who are unsure of their career path and would like to gain experience in different industries
- Those who have an idea of which career path they would like to take but would like to develop their employability skills further
- Those who would like to undertake further studies to achieve additional level 2 'real-world' related qualifications
- Those who would prefer an alternative to traditional educational routes
- Those who would like the opportunity to retake Maths and English up to Level 2

The programme runs from <u>September 2021 to June 2022</u> and includes:

- Work experience placement(s) in chosen area
- A dedicated professional coach and mentor using a student-centred approach
- Personal development and employability training informed by industry related research
- Industry insights
